- Brief examination
- FVRCP vaccination (feline rhinotracheitis, calicivirus and panleukopenia)
- FeLV vaccination (feline leukemia)
- Fecal test - if not previously done
- Hospital tour
- Declaw

3rd visit (15-16 weeks):

- Brief examination
- Leukemia vaccination
- Rabies vaccination at 16 weeks
- Fecal test
